The 20th Anniversary Meeting of the Southeast Asian Linguistics Society

Zurich, Switzerland, June 10-11, 2010

The conference features papers on the languages of Southeast Asia, including Austroasiatic, Austronesian, Hmong-Mien, Tibeto-Burman and Tai-Kadai. Topics include descriptive, theoretical, and historical linguistics, linguistic anthropology (ethnolinguistics, language attitudes and ideology, discourse and conversational analysis, language and gender, language and politics), language planning, literacy and bilingual education.
